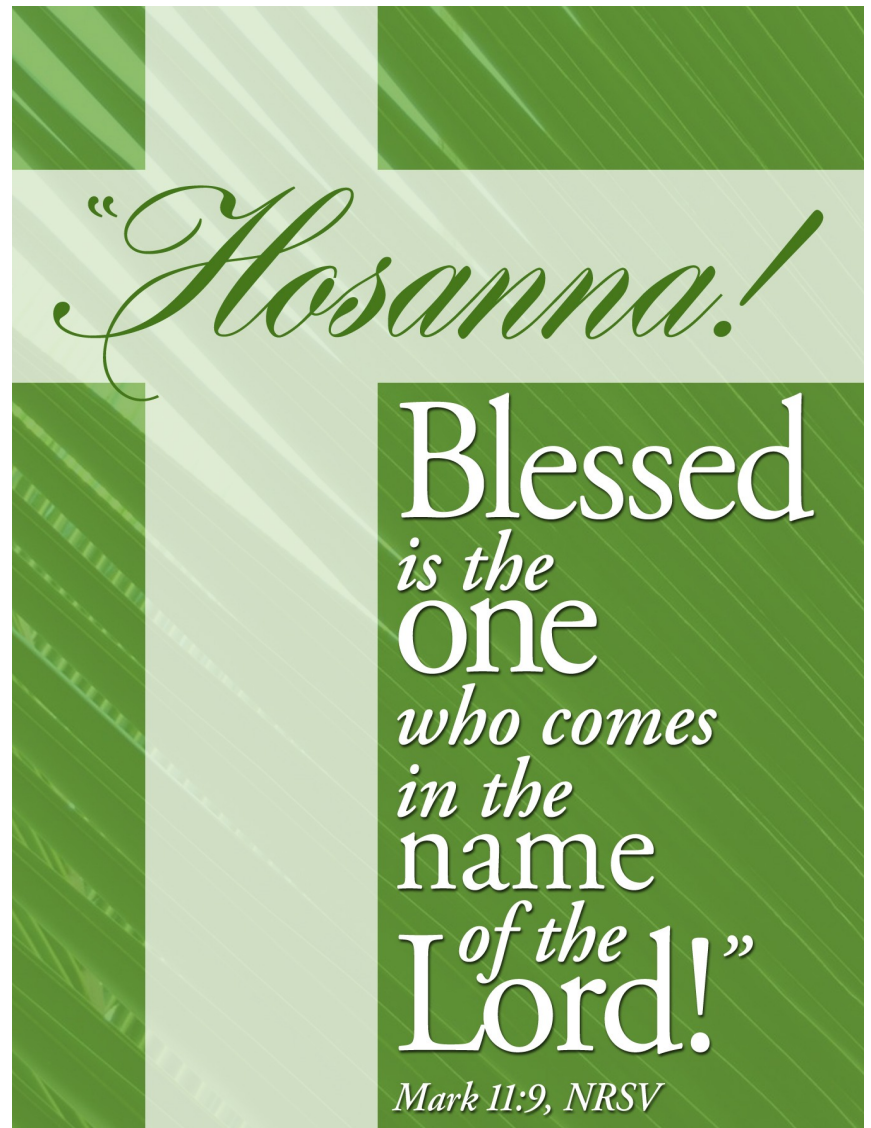

Board Chairman Synopsis

1st Quarter Board Meeting

January 25, 2016

The purpose of this article is to give some of the high points of our January Board Meeting.

1. Treasurer, Mike Corkran, presented the budget for 2016. The total budget is \$470,000.00. This budget amount is spread among the various ministry teams in our church; Property, Stewardship, Worship, Membership, Evangelism, Outreach, and Christian Education. We projected \$53,000.00 less income for 2016 due to members who have passed away or left the church. We have projected \$51,000.00 less in expenses, leaving the church with a \$10,538.00 budgeted loss. We were able to achieve this budget by tightening up on several ministries and switching the janitorial duties to our Hispanic Minister, Jesus Bulnes.
2. The Honduras Ministry trip headed up by Reverend Elli Bulnes has been postponed for this year. Elli will announce the dates for the trip in 2017.
3. We are waiting on additional information on establishing a Church Security Team.
4. Our first skate night for the children in over 2 years was approved. The Pioneer Sunday school class sponsored the event on February 13th. Thanks to the Pioneer Class for a successful event.
5. Dennis Murray gave a Property report that included progress on clearing the McGuire land. Bids have been taken to clear the land, but first, we will be asking for help from Church members. It is my understanding that the Sunday School classes will be asked to coordinate a clean-up date. More to follow on the adventure.

I know I have not touched on everything that was discussed at the Board Meeting, and I would encourage each and everyone to attend the next meeting scheduled for March 21, 2016 @ 6:00 P.M. in the Fellowship Hall. I would like to thank each member of Kings Highway Christian Church for all your work, prayers , and input into our Beautiful Church. 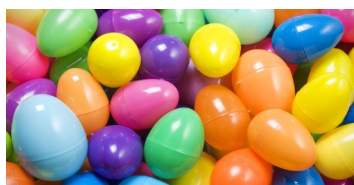
