From The Minister

recently heard the proposal that a church's success can be measured by how busy its parking lot is during the week. I'm not sure if this is true or not, but it is an idea worth considering. So since the weather is so beautiful, why don't you and I sit down here next to our church's parking lot and see how many cars go in and out during the week?

We all know that the lot is full of cars on Sunday morning, but we will also find plenty of cars on Sunday afternoon for our afternoon youth meetings. Cars will be coming and going before and after the weekly practices for our chancel choir and our praise band. There may not be a lot of cars for our Monday morning elders' meeting, but they are here so early in the morning they will definitely get our notice. Our Ministry to the Hispanic Community offers weekly English classes on Monday and Wednesday evenings (with 42 students registered this spring semester, this is a busy time for the parking lot) and there's also a Bible studies in Spanish following the English classes. There will be plenty of cars parked for our Wednesday morning Bible Study, and even more for our monthly Joy Fellowship (coming up this Monday).

If you had been watching closely over the last month you would have seen cars parked outside for two successful skate night activities sponsored by the Pioneer and Discovery Sunday school classes. You would have also seen cars in the parking lot for two practices for Youth Sunday, for pastor's class, for two very productive Saturday workdays sponsored by the Pioneer class, and for the DWM Retreat and monthly meeting. If we are counting cars I suppose I shouldn't forget the recent meetings of the following teams: our board, financial oversight, curriculum, Christian ed, evangelism and outreach. You will also see Dennis Murray's truck in the parking lot quite regularly during most weeks. He is the leader of our property team and his truck is up here about as much as the car of our board chair, Bobby Shields. But the car we will see parked in the parking lot most often, particularly at odd house, is that of Wayne and Elli Boyd who no doubt will be busy taking care of one chore or another.

Of course the parking lot also fills up because of the many outside group meetings. A part of our ministry to the community is to provide space free of charge or for a token amount to these groups. There are the seven AA meetings during the week (don't expect to park near the church when those are going on—lots of cars), and there are two NA (Narcotics Anonymous) meetings. We host a support group for the families of those suffering from mental health issues. The parking lot also fills up with the monthly meetings of the organization of Retired Teachers as well as meetings of the leadership of the Boy Scouts.

Here's one more time when our parking lot is busy... At 3:30 each school day you will see our church parking lot filling up with parents and caregivers picking up students from C.E. Byrd High School. This is a way that we support both Byrd and St. Marks, by providing this space for pick up and overflow parking for some of their special events. (A small ministry to be sure but one some of us have fought for and of which we are proud).

So, is the busyness of a church's parking lot a good gauge of its success? I sure hope it is.


A lunch of hamburgers, hot dogs and soft drinks will be served at noon!
