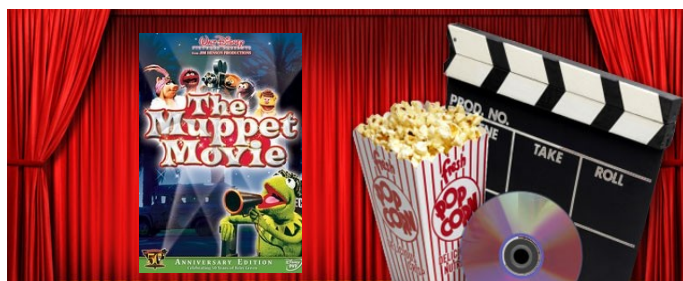

Sept. 18, it would be greatly appreciated. You can leave the donations in the church office, the collection barrel in the "fish bowl", or at the front of the sanctuary. Most needed items at present are: canned green beans (15-16 ounces), spaghetti (16 ounce box or package), and boxed stuffing mix.

Your donations are greatly appreciated and serve people right here in this community. During the month of July, the Food Pantry served 777 clients, 459 households, 56 homeless persons, and handed out 233 bags of pet food.
