Capital Campaign Update

The Stewardship committee would like to thank everyone who participated in the Capital Campaign. We are very appreciative for the pledges that have been received. Our goal was to have monthly pledges of \$7000 totaling \$84,000 for the first year of the three-year campaign. Our mortgage is over \$6000 a month and then we were hoping to leave some funds for repairs. So far, we can expect to receive \$59,260 for the first year. We have not yet met our goal but are still hopeful that there may be more pledges and gifts to come. Our facilities mean a great deal to our church family as well as the community. Continuing our commitment to foster Christian love and service to others is what we hope to accomplish through our facilities and congregation. Again, thank you for your past, present and future support of our church.
