He and his mom, Maria Lopez, have been at Casa Esperanza since June 20th and are going back home this weekend.

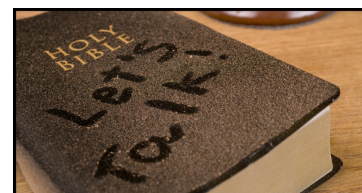
