Advice from Our Church Treasurer

If you are over 70 ½ years old and are required to take an RMD (Required Minimum Distribution) from your retirement plan or IRA you can advise the holder of your plan to send it directly to a charity. It cannot go through you, it **must** go directly from the fund to the charity. It satisfies the RMD and is not reportable as income. But it is also not deductible as a contribution - because you didn't have to show it as

income. There is a limit however. You can only send \$100,000 per year So, if you will not be able to itemize, with the standard deduction having been raised to \$24,000 for married couples filing jointly, it would be wise to take advantage of this provision and still get the deduction since you are not having to declare it as income.
