Highland Blessing Dinner Information Note from Allen Swilley

The Highland Blessing Dinner began 8 years ago and originated as an outreach of the Church for the Highlands on Olive Street. The idea behind this endeavor is to serve the

homeless and working poor in the Highland area. At the beginning all churches in the area were invited to participate by helping with the actual serving of the dinner. Participating churches provide workers for the dinner, who act as servers for the food and as table hosts at the tables where the meal is served. The churches in the area are assigned specific Thursday nights to supply workers. Kings Highway church has been assigned the 1st Thursday of each month. Other churches are assigned different weeks, an in the case of a 5th Thursday all churches are encouraged to participate.

Our duties are simple: care for the unfortunate in our neighborhood, and sometimes surrounding area. On each Thursday evening the workers (volunteers) gather in the gym area at Highland Center at 5:30 pm for an orientation while the neighborhood people gather in the Chapel. At 6:00 pm the people for the chapel come into the gym area and go to assigned tables where their table host greets them and servers provide cold drinks of tea, lemonade, or water and other servers bring serving dishes of fresh hot food. At approximately 6:20, most have finished eating, and one of the volunteers from the current week's church provides a devotional and a prayer, and the diners return home, while the volunteers clear the tables and put them away; and all is done by 7:00.

As an organizer from the beginning of this dinner, I have found this to be a blessing for me, and I am sure the food and fellowship is a blessing for the participants. There are times we feed 50 people and other times we feed 90 people. We need volunteers to be handy for whatever occurs.

I ask that as members of KHCC, you consider joining Carla and I on at least the 1st Thursday of the month, and more weeks if you can. Carla and I are present at all dinners, and have grown to love those that come to have dinner.

What is the mission of Patterns for Patients?

Patterns for Patients' mission is to collect fabric for Shriners Hospitals for Children Orthotic and Prosthetic department. The material SHOULDN'T be stretchy or furry, but SHOULD be the same material as most pillow cases and not have much give to it. Below are some examples of how donated fabrics will be incorporated into a child's new prosthetic limb.

NO: stretchy, furry, jersey material, flannel, or fleece.
