The Outreach Committee is pleased to report that the congregation has responded very well to the outreach ministries offered in this first quarter of the church year.

- We hosted 20 children and 2 sponsors from the CRI's Highland Friendship House at Trejo's for their first "Report Card Dinner" of the year.
- We had 16 donors give blood on February 17.
- We contributed 195 cans of soup and 129 packages of cornbread to Noel Food Pantry. The youth also collected \$136 on Souper Bowl Sunday for the food pantry.
