This week focuses on the second component of interim ministry, which is a shared task with the whole congregation - *Utilizing the possibilities of the “between” time*. This includes:

Helping the congregation with healthy goodbyes

Making contact (or insuring contact is made) with all members of the church family

Helping the leadership in reviewing programs, procedures, and ministries for updates and changes

Encouraging healthy processes and systems to deal with conflict and anxiety that often comes with change

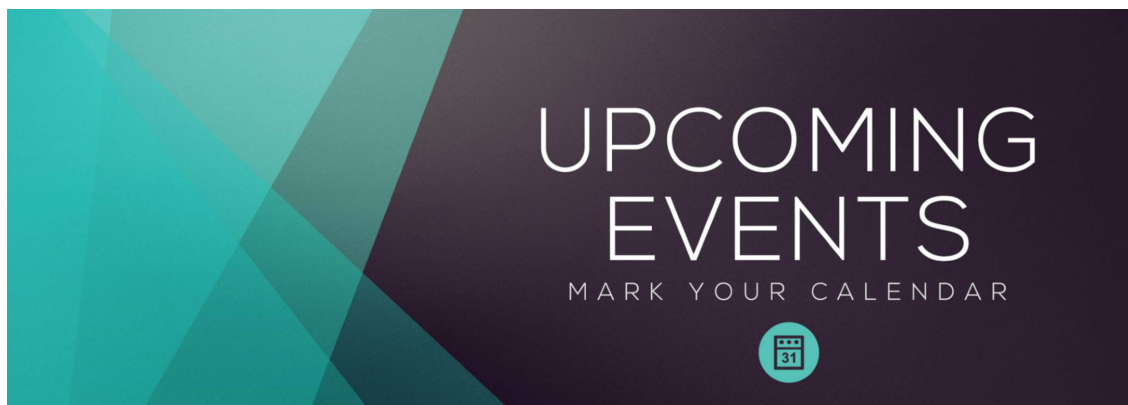
Updating records and other administrative housecleaning
