## A Report from the Treasurer

Hello fellow members of Kings Highway Christian Church. As you will see from the Statement of Receipts and Disbursements included with this report, from January through April we spent more than we took in. This is primarily due to two things. Our 96 year old building has needed continued repair and maintenance as it probably will from now on. We spent \$31,628 more than we thought we would on Maintenance and repair in the first four months primarily due to replacing air conditioners. In addition, we spent \$3,600 more on our note than we received for that purpose. Fortunately, we had a generous contribution from a non-member that kept us closer to our budget than we would have been without it. But May is starting off with a bang. We collected almost \$11,000 May 5. That is great and will help us keep our heads above water.
