I have two congenital heart defects. I was diagnosed with Hypoplastic Left Heart Syndrome and Atrial Septal Defect. I've had two open heart surgeries to help my heart pump more oxygen rich blood than oxygen poor or mixed oxygen blood. I've also had a third open heart surgery to repair the Coarctation of my Aortic Arch. I'm as cute as can be and have the most adorable smile ever! If you've ever met me, you'd never know I have only half of a heart!



DYLAN BROUSSARD



Dylan Broussard, of Carlyss, LA was diagnosed with T-cell Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (ALL) in October 2016. Tests have revealed that the cancer has spread over 79% of his body. After the initial shock, Dylan realized that he has to be **STRONG** to win this battle and needs the support of others in his fight. Dylan is a senior in high school and enjoys working out and spending time with his family and friends. Dylan lost his grandfather to cancer in March and his grandmother was recently diagnosed with Non-Hodgkin's Leukemia.

With the help of blood donors, Dylan can be **#DylanStrong** and receive the lifesaving treatment he needs to continue battling his ALL.
