## Message from Board Chair

It is an exciting time as we are about to begin a new chapter at Kings Highway. We have begun the process to search for a new senior minister. We are about to start the Epiphany process to look at our church mission and how we can best serve the community. This process has three parts. The assessor from Hope Partnership will meet with church officers on August 14. This evaluation will include tours of the church and community. Discussions will be held with the ministers, the church treasurer and staff of the church concerning our programs, worship, and the community outreach.

A second phase will unfold with a retreat on September 14th and 15th for all the church leaders. The Hope Facilitator will lead us into engaging the church leaders during this two-day retreat to move from managing the church into one of transforming our community. A second retreat will take place on November 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> to focus on the development of a future story for Kings Highway as we develop visions for the church and how we will reach out to transform the community.

Hope Partnership will provide a follow up process to support and guide us through embracing this new mind set. I ask for your prayers so that we may be granted patience as we discover together the Will of God for Kings Highway. We will seek that moment of divine insight described by the word Epiphany itself. May we be granted discernment for God's vision as our congregation is in partnership with the Holy Spirit.
