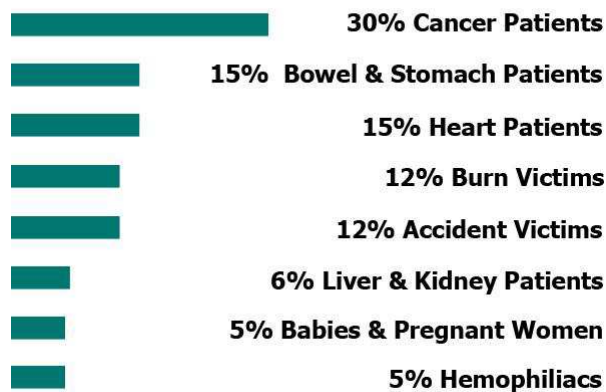

WHY SHOULD I GIVE BLOOD?

Someone will need blood every two seconds and just one donation can save up to three lives. With all the wonderful advances in modern medicine, there is no manufactured substitute for human blood. It must be provided by volunteer blood donors in the community.

One in three people need blood in their lifetime. If you don't need blood, it's almost certain that someone close to you will. As a community blood center, LifeShare provides the blood components to hospitals and medical facilities in the community. As you can imagine, I've been to a lot of church meeting, seminars, and retreats. I can't remember any of them that were as universally well received as our Epiphany Retreat last weekend. Forty people participated in this two-day event. It was well planned, well time structured, and well received. The realities of how people communicate today, their often negative view of Christianity, and the fluid demographics of our community were made clear. We were encouraged to ask "why" we do what we do as a church, not just "what" or "how." We looked at our leadership styles and our temptation to say "no" to mission and new ideas. We discussed the difference between being "members" and being "disciples." We affirmed our strengths and were open about our weaknesses, and realized that our mission is God given and to our community.

This Epiphany process will continue to unfold over the next year. The next event is scheduled for November, but I will use a number of Retreat I's themes over the next weeks in worship. This coming week will look at membership and discipleship.

Board Report

The Official Board met 9/16/19 with sixteen members and eight guests in attendance.

Among the Committee reports presented:

Outreach outlined the planned special offering for the rest of the year. Over 1800 items have been donated to the Noel Food Pantry. Chair Betty Webster encouraged us to drop by the Pantry and see how that ministry is functioning.

Property reported replacement of the roofs on the Family Life Center, Education building, and Walkway will begin in two or three weeks. The cost of this work will be covered by insurance. Telephone and Internet service is now with Conterra (a substantial savings over our previous carrier.) Plans to paint the sanctuary windows will be revisited in February. Recent needed AC repairs have not been expensive.

Trustees continue their work to reach an acceptable settlement for damage to the Sanctuary roof.

New Business

Adopted the *Ethical Guidelines for Congregational Conduct Christian Church (Disciples of Christ)* “to help us make specific application of our New Testament faith to our practices as a congregation.” Copies of this document are available in the office and in the narthex.

Approved the creation of a *Safety and Security Team* for KHCC. Barry Eakin has agreed to chair this group. A suggested beginning plan to respond to emergency situations (dangerous weather, health emergencies, threats, evacuation of the building) is available for the team’s use.

Approved the report of the Trustees to move forward with a possible real estate sale.

Received the report of the By-Laws Committee

Approved expenditures of \$1,326.13 by Property and Education.

On September 16, 2019, the official Board of Kings Highway Christian Church voted to approve the Trustees to proceed with the sale of the adjacent real estate, known as Casa Esperanza and the McGuire property for the purpose of paying off the debt of the church and to have additional monies for the ministries of the church.

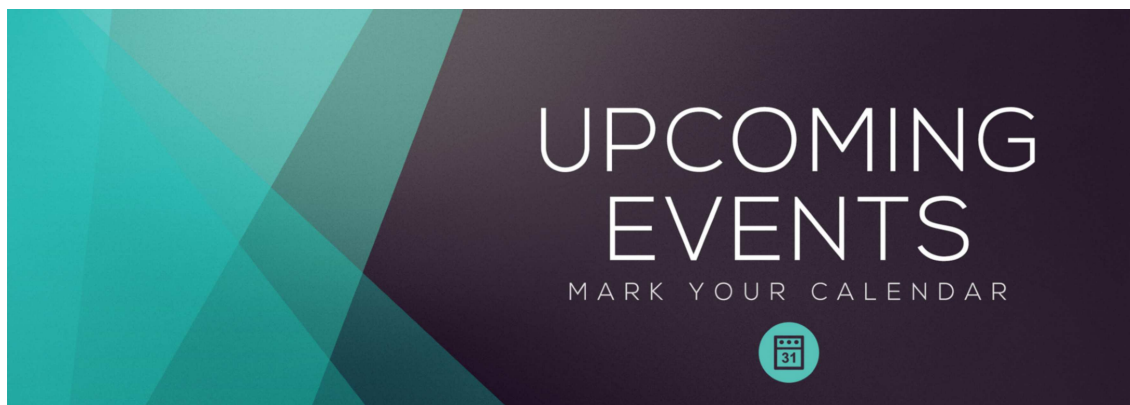
