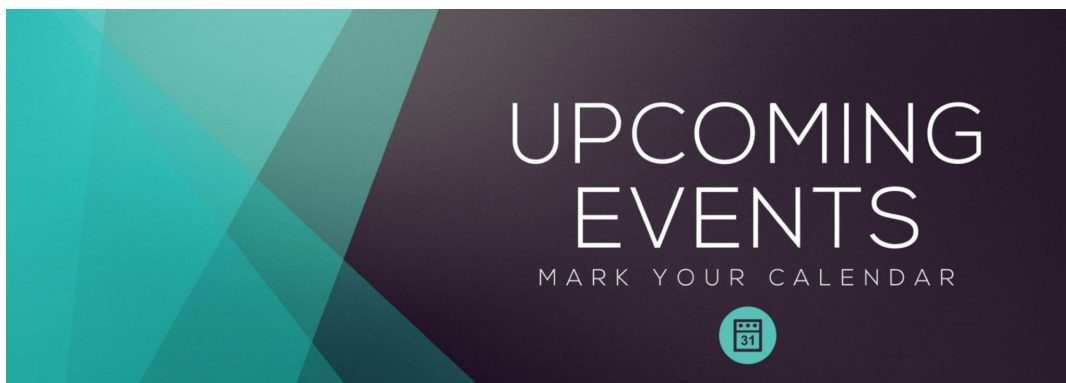

We have been pleased with the quality of the leadership and reports so far in this process, and expect this next step will enable us to move forward effectively.
